**Walter (Wally) Rhodes,
Camira Orchids,
Tea Gardens. NSW**

Wally has been growing orchids for more than 50 years. He specialises in Paphs and has been breeding them since 1968. Wally established Camira Orchids in 1976 with a breeding, flasking and growing program for Paphs, Odonts, Sarcophilus and Miltonia. The production side of his enterprise was moved to Taiwan in 2003. Wally has been a Judge since 1964 and has officiated in Australia and at various overseas events and World Congresses. He was a Guest Speaker at the September 2014 Tasmania Orchid Conference in Launceston, alongside Ray Clement and Scott Barrie. Wally's history with the Annual March Workshop program goes back to the 1999 Workshop conducted by the Sapphire Coast Club and then as one of "the three amigos" at Tuross Head in March 2015.

**Clive Halls,
Mt Beenak Orchids,
Three Bridges. Vic**

Clive's introduction to orchids was as an Apprentice Nurseryman to Sanders Orchids UK. Following resettlement in Australia, Clive and wife Agi established Mt Beenak Orchids in 1979. They have specialized in cool growing orchids and now concentrate on Masdevallias, Oncids, Zygopetalums and Sarcophilus and undertake most of their own breeding and germination in their own lab. Clive took on an amount of Neville Roper's breeding stock when Neville became ill, and has faithfully followed Neville's Sarcophilus breeding program and objectives. Clive was a Guest Speaker at the 2009 Annual March Workshop held at Tathra and that same year joined Kevin Hipkins as a keynote speaker at the 18th AOC Conference. Clive was the third of "the three amigos" at the 2015 Tuross Head March Workshop. His sessions at this workshop will concentrate on practical growing tips for Sarcophilus, Masdevallias and Odontoglossums.

**Kevin Hipkins,
Royale Orchids,
Peats Ridge. NSW**

Royale Orchids was established by Kevin's parents (Roy and Alice, hence Royale) some 50 years ago and subsequently relocated from Woy Woy to acreage at Peats Ridge. The Nursery has developed from a backyard operation into one of the largest specialist orchid nurseries in NSW under Kevin's leadership. Kevin is known worldwide for his hybridizing programs using Cym tracyanum and Cym erythraeum to achieve new colour forms within hybrid cymbidiums. He took NSW Orchid Society 2012 Species of the Year with Cym erythraeum 'Paradise.' Kevin has been a regular speaker at the Cymbidium Society of America Annual Conference, Santa Barbara. Kevin has history on the South Coast – he was the Speaker at the EOC's October 1997 Meeting on his way to that year's Regional Conference in Bega and was involved with, and sponsored, EOC's "Orchid Odyssey 2001" Show and Regional Conference at Batemans Bay. His most recent appearance on the Coast was at the 2015 Tuross Head March Workshop as one of "the three amigos." As with the other speakers, Kevin's sessions will be practical and will include one on growing orchids into specimens.

**Jeanne Dunn,
Passion Orchids,
Briagalong, Vic**

Jeanne's selection of the name Passion Orchids only hints at her overall passion for what she does with Dockrillias. Her vitality and enthusiasm is infectious. She lives and operates her small nursery "off grid" close to the snowline in East Gippsland, Victoria and has collected and bred some outstanding examples of this genera.
