# MACARTHUR ANOS REPORT For ANOS Inc Meeting September 2024

#### Overview

Macarthur and Districts ANOS was established in 1990 and is a relatively small society of active growers of all varieties of Australasian orchids. The group is active in encouraging native orchid growing as well as supporting local native orchid conservation.

### **Membership and Committee**

Macarthur ANOS currently has 52 members with 5 new members joining the group during the last 12-month period.

At the 2024 Macarthur ANOS AGM held in July, our long-term President - Wally Southwell and his Committee Member wife – Margaret Southwell stood down after over 20 years in these positions. This decision was based on Wally not being able to drive at night and as such would be unable to attend winter meetings. ### **Monthly Meeting**

In 2024, our monthly meetings were face-to-face gatherings. These meetings have been well attended by over 30 members and visitors each month. ZOOM options have been maintained for members as well as providing an option

for presentations. Monthly benching of plants averaged 55 over the last 12 months and 60% of members benched plants over the year. Meetings always had either an arranged presentation / presenter for the evening or a benching report was delivered by one of our members.

This year we introduced a "Orchid Growers Support segment" as part of our monthly meeting agendas and members are active to seek out advice, learn growing techniques and ask questions.

After introducing in 2023, we have continued with the 'Plant Growing" segment at each meeting – where 4 selected plants are spoken about by growers on their successful growing skills. This is well received by all and creates a better community for all members.

The benching of plants at the monthly meetings occurs across 21 sections. A 'Plant of the Night' is selected by the judges and 'Popular Choice' is selected by members / visitors in attendance. Annually, prize money and trophy are awarded to the 'Point score Champion' plus second and third placegetters. The Terry Cooke Memorial Champion Terrestrial Grower Award is presented to growers accumulating points from monthly and show benching's.


#### **Annual Shows**

### **Funding**

Apart from the \$15 annual membership subscription, Macarthur ANOS conducts monthly and show raffles / sales table activities.

Macarthur ANOS also received a Council grant in 2024.

• Camden Council – Community Sponsorship Program - \$1560 – for Champion and Sectional Prize Money for the 2024 Spring and Late Spring Shows.

## **Conservation Projects**

Macarthur ANOS and its members currently has a variety of conservation items happening

- i) *Macarthur Native Orchid Survey* this project initially funded by AGL and later Camden Council has allowed the society to engage with local Councils and other community members to survey orchid species and populations throughout Macarthur. The current survey has identified 109 orchids species 30 of which are new observations since the 1995 survey. Ten species listed on the 1995 survey are yet to be seen. The current survey has seen over 2,400 observations logged in iNaturalist by over 100 community members.
- ii) *Pterostylis saxicola* population mapping Macarthur ANOS is actively supporting Campbelltown Council in mapping *Pterostylis saxicola* populations. The Pterostylis saxicola project has been added to the Dept of Environment 'Save our Species' Project and Macarthur ANOS members have assisted with DNA sampling.
- iii) **Pterostylis gibbosa reintroductions** Macarthur ANOS is investigating the opportunity to establish a reintroduction program of *Pterostylis gibbosa* into some Illawarra locations. The Pterostylis gibbosa project has been added to the Dept of Environment 'Save our Species' Project and Macarthur ANOS members have begun meeting with the coordinators.
- iv) *Rhizanthella sp Project* Macarthur ANOS members found this species in Dharawal National Park in late April 2024. This species has its own Dept of Environment 'Save our Species' Project and Macarthur ANOS members have collected DNA with the state coordinators and are awaiting flowering in September. A further 7 plants have been found in close proximity.
- v) **Royal Botanic Gardens Mt Annan** Macarthur ANOS is corresponding with Mt Annan to see if we can support the Gardens Native Orchid projects.

#### **Communication Activities**

Macarthur ANOS has an active Facebook Group Page (at least 3 post per week) at <u>Macarthur ANOS Group</u>. This page currently has over 580 members and allows us to:

- a. Communicate to members and potential members,
- b. Promote our activities,
- c. Disseminate other interesting articles about native orchids.

- d. Allows the community to ask questions, highlight their finds,
- e. Highlight Macarthur ANOS successes.
