Note 1 Accounting principles & background

These accounts have been prepared to meet the Society's obligations under its Constitution.

The accounts are prepared on the accrual basis whereby expenditure is matched to the same period as related revenue even though the actual expenditure may occur in a different financial year.

The Society's main source of income is from membership subscriptions and its main area of expenditure is the production and distribution of its quarterly publication The Orchadian.
