Treasurer's Statement Accompanying Financial Statements for the Year Ended 30th June 2024

Financial Position

In preparing the financial accounts for the 2023/24 year changes have been made to more closely report the financial result for the year and also to show more clearly the funds available for the future activities of the Australian Native Orchid Society Inc (the Organisation). This has resulted in a substantial reported loss for the year but this is largely due to the application of accounting principles and does not represent a significant deterioration in the financial position of the Organisation. The underlying result for the year is broadly similar with that for the previous year.

As described below, some funds are held but are not able to be applied to the general use of the Organisation. In past years, when these funds have been received they have been reported in the Profit or Loss of the Organisation for that period. As these funds are not available for general use they should not be included in the calculation of profits and hence in these financial accounts are removed from the calculation of profits as Prior Period Adjustments.

I will now expand on the financial position of the Organisation.

1 - Loss for the year

The underlying net loss for the financial year is (\$7869.19). This is reconciled with the reported net loss as follows:
